The Excelsior Springs Parks and Recreation Board meeting held July 28, 2026 at the Excelsior Springs Community Center was called to order by President Zac Wilkins at 6:02 p.m.

Nate Williams informed the Board that it is budget time. City Manager Melinda Mehaffy will present the ESPRCC Budget to the City Council on Friday morning because he has prior commitments.

STAFF REPORTS

Mowing continues. There has been some vandalism in the parks - graffiti.

The ADA adjustable height changing table in the women's restroom at Rainbow Splash Park has been damaged. Chad Clevenger and Nate Williams are working on a repair solution.

Alexis Blankenship updated the Board on the youth soccer programs. MLSGo is expensive - a whole uniform has to be ordered - jersey, shorts, and socks. Jerseys cannot be ordered by themselves. MLSGo will be offered in the spring because a Grant was awarded to the Department for the spring season. Lexi talked with MLSGo about ordering jerseys only and not the whole uniform kit but that conversation was unproductive.

Happy Feet's representatives have not been the same contact person and Lexi is not getting the same response from people.

AYSO or in house instruction could be considered..

Drake Pollard reported that FEAT numbers are on the increase. Ty Caesar will be staying on and working on camps and skills. Ty will start in August.

Nate Williams reported that there have been some change orders for the playground at Boundless Backyard - removing the tunnel and replacing it with a ground trampoline

and moving signs to open up play spaces.

Boundless Backyard's playground concept design is by Harper's Playground but will probably not make their premier certification list.
